Parents (and Children's Ministry supporters)! Ever wished you had a "what to expect" book for the years *after* your child was born? You can now! You're invited this spring to explore the book, "It's Just A Phase - So Don't Miss It". Join other parents exploring what kids need, from ages 0 to 18, led by Tammy Burdick. You'll learn and discuss each phase over the course of 3 sessions, held once a month. The first session will be Wednesday, March 22, with dinner at 5:00 p.m. and discussion from 5:15 - 6:30 p.m. Books are \$20 through the church. If you're in, RSVP to Tammy, either in-person or through GroupMe to get a headcount for dinner.
